Terms and Conditions

The Adoptee agrees to abide by the following clauses in relation to the Animal being adopted:

1. To keep and abide by the animal protection laws/regulations of Spain, including but not limited to,ensuring there is no mistreatment or cruelty of the animal,to feed and adequately look after the Animal and ensure there is no unnecessary suffering or injury.
2. Dogs should live within a family environment in the house or the apartment. Permanent outside Kennels and chain positions where the Animal is chained up are not permitted.
3. The Animal has been health checked by a veterinarian and appears healthy at the time of adoption by the Adoptee (unless otherwise noted). This does not exclude that the Animal may have a dormant and therefore not recognizable disease that occurs. No responsibility can be accepted by Cats Welfare in such circumstances.
4. If at any time the Animal becomes/appears ill,the Adoptee agrees that they will take the animal to a veterinarian without delay and have it treated as per the advice of the veterinarian.
5. The Animal must not be used for breeding or any other commercial purpose.
6. The Adoptee agrees to the sterilisation or castration of the animal without delay once it has reached an appropriate age. For cats this is at 4 months of age,
7. The Animal shall not be sold or given to any third party for permanent care without the express prior permission of Cats Welfare.
8. The Adoptee must inform Cats Welfare immediately if the Animal has a serious accident, dies or is lost.
9. In situations such as a holiday where the Animal is unable to accompany the Adoptee or during an illness of the Adoptee the Animal must be placed in care of a responsible adult or organisation that is able to suitably care for the Animal. That adult or organisation must be made aware of the obligations of this contract and agree to adhere to the clauses within it.
10. If euthanasia of the Animal is necessary it is only to be performed by a veterinarian and after consultation with Cats Welfare. Cats Welfare reserves the option to consult with another vet(s) for advice and reserves the right to take back the animal. Only when absolutely necessary (for example in an emergency) and that prior approval cannot be obtained from Cats Welfare then the need for the euthanasia must be confirmed by a veterinarian in writing and the Adoptee must inform Cats Welfare without delay and provide the written vet agreement that it was necessary.
11. The Adoptee agrees,to allow Cats Welfare at any time,to satisfy themselves of the satisfactory condition/well-being of the Animal and compliance with these contractual obligations and for that purpose to enter the premises where the Animal is located.
12. If the Adoptee can no longer look after or adequately care for the Animal the Adoptee will inform Cats Welfare. Cats Welfare will do what it can to find a suitable alternative home but ultimate responsibility remains with the Adoptee. A claim for any reimbursement of any costs incurred by the Adoptee including but not limited to any adoption donation paid to Cats Welfare is excluded.
13. The Adoptee agrees that Cats Welfare is entitled to demand the immediate return of the Animal,if the Adoptee fails to adhere to these contractual obligations.
